<p>For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith." (Ro 1:16-17, ESV)</p>	<p>As it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; no one understands; no one seeks for God. (Romans 3:10-11 ESV)</p>	<p>For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23 ESV)</p>
<p>And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness, (Romans 4:5 ESV)</p>	<p>Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:1 ESV)</p>	<p>For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. (Romans 5:6 ESV)</p>
<p>But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8 ESV)</p>	<p>Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned (Romans 5:12 ESV)</p>	<p>What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it? (Romans 6:1-2 ESV)</p>
<p>Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness. (Ro 6:12-13 ESV)</p>	<p>For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace.(Romans 6:14 ESV)</p>	<p>For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23 ESV)</p>
<p>For I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate. (Romans 7:15 ESV)</p>	<p>Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin. (Romans 7:24-25 ESV)</p>	<p>There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Romans 8:1 ESV)</p>
<p>For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. (Romans 8:7-8 ESV)</p>	<p>For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us. (Romans 8:18 ESV)</p>	<p>And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. (Romans 8:28 ESV)</p>

<p>For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. And those whom he predestined he also called, and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified. (Ro 8:29-30 ESV)</p>	<p>Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (Romans 8:35, 37 ESV)</p>	<p>For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Ro 8:38-39 ESV)</p>
<p>So then it depends not on human will or exertion, but on God, who has mercy. (Romans 9:16 ESV)</p>	<p>Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. (Ro 10:9-10, ESV)</p>	<p>How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" (Ro 10:14-15 ESV)</p>
<p>Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! (Romans 11:33 ESV)</p>	<p>For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen. (Romans 11:36 ESV)</p>	<p>I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. (Romans 12:1 ESV)</p>
<p>Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. (Ro 12:2 ESV)</p>	<p>If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. (Romans 12:18 ESV)</p>	<p>Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. (Romans 12:21 ESV)</p>
<p>But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires. (Romans 13:14 ESV)</p>	<p>Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother. (Romans 14:13 ESV)</p>	<p>The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. (Romans 16:20 ESV)</p>
